2. ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

Paediatric Oncology is functioning as a separate unit in the department of medical oncology from July 1992. At the 41st meeting of the governing council held on 29th December 2008 was created as Department of Paediatric Oncology.

The Department of Paediatric Oncology was created as an independent Department with effect 28th March 2009 as per official Memorandum No.KIMO/EST/1/94/2008-2009 dated 28.3.2009.

3. FACILITIES AVAILABE IN THE DEPARTMENT

Diagnostic, protocol based treatment and supportive treatment facilities for both out patients and in patients.

The Department trains DM students in Medical Oncology and Postgraduate/DNB students of Paediatrics posted from various Medical colleges of Karnataka.

The Department has also started a Fellowship training programme from January 2010 and trains the fellow for a period of 2 years.
